Course Fee \$135.00, includes supply kit, potting's, and camp T-shirt. Kids must bring sack lunch and beverage.

Kids "Sew Now" Camp Ages 10-14, July20-23. Mon-Thurs, 9am -2pm. Kids learn to machine sew, design patterns and create a garment and tote bag. Learn practical sewing skills while having fun and feeling good about their accomplishments. Course Fee \$140.00, includes supplies, fabric, and camp T-shirt. Kids must bring Sewing Machine, sack lunch and beverage.

"Box City" Build a City! Ages 7-12, July 27-31. Mon-Fri, 9am-2pm. Build "Historic St. Augustine". Box City camp provides a hands-on experimental approach to community planning and design principles. Students create buildings out of boxes and recycled materials, while learning how geography, economics, history, and cultures have affected the development of the community. Guest speakers to talk about architecture, urban planning, and the history of St. Augustine. Class ends on Friday afternoon followed by a viewing reception of the "Box City", for parents and City & College dignitaries. Class Fee \$155.00, includes all art supplies, and camp T-shirt.
