OK, I couldn't wait so we will begin with the BIG news! However, there is more important news to follow so please be sure to read all the way through. Late last week, the district informed me that Palencia Elementary will soon become a one-to-one school. As we are a digital school and our textbooks are delivered in a digital format, we will be given additional devices to complete our goal to be 1:1. I am not sure the exact device we will have yet, but the third. fourth and fifth graders will probably be using some type of laptop. The current iPads will then move to Kindergarten, First and Second Grades. We can expect this to occur during late January or February. Earlier in the year, I held meeting to discuss our move to a 1:1 school. We are very thankful that the district is going to help us accomplish this goal. If you have purchased an iPad for your child to use in school, they will still be able to use their personal device if you wish. You also have the option of bringing in any personally owned iPad for us to load the textbooks and any other important apps that we have and are allowed to install on your machine. This will hopefully eliminate the need to carry devices to and from school. There is still a lot more information to be shared about this process and I will be sharing more in the coming weeks as more decisions are made. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions.

Reminder: Next Friday, Dec. 20th, is an Early Release Day prior to the Winter Break. Students will be dismissed an hour early at 1:50pm. School will resume for students on Tuesday, January7th, 2014.

Another Reminder: Morning drop off begins at 8:10am. Only patrols and students that have made special arrangements with a teacher should be dropped off earlier than 8:10am. This becomes a safety concern as there is no supervision until 8:10. Thank you for your cooperation.
