The St. Johns County School District's (SJCSD) bus routes for the 2015-2016 school year were approved by the School Board at their May 12 meeting. The routes are available online at www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/transportation/routes. Parents without access to computers may visit any of the county public library locations, and staff will assist them in locating the website.

In mid-July, postcards will be sent home to the parents of all potential bus riders giving them the bus stop, times and bus number for their students. The Transportation Department will operate 175 bus routes and transport approximately 60 percent of the district's students twice a day when school starts on Monday, August 10.
