Happy New Year! The teachers, staff, and I were so excited to welcome our students back yesterday. Their smiles and joy are truly contagious.

Palencia Elementary continues to grow. Ten new students are starting this week bringing our enrollment to 848.

As we enter the 3rd nine weeks of school, as in years past, we look closely at any student who has consistently fallen below grade level expectations in Reading and / or Math this school year. In the weeks ahead, teachers will be asked to identify "possible retention candidates". Those parents will be notified and a plan will be put in place specific to the child's needs. The goal is for home and school to work together so that any gaps in learning can be remediated and retention be avoided.

On the horizon are plans to expand Palencia's current school playground and to add a NEW Kindergarten /  $1^{\rm st}$  grade playground. Stay tuned.



Auditions for the spring musical, Willy Wonka Kids, will be held on January 16, 22 and 23, 2019, after school. Auditions are open to all current PES students. Please read the following important small print before registering for the auditions.

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AUDITION REQUIREMENTS: Each child will be required to sing

part of a song from Willy Wonka Kids—the links to the songs to choose from are on the back of this paper. EVERY child who is auditioning <u>must</u> sing one of the songs indicated. In addition, each child will be required to read from a script with other students during the auditions. Pre-readers will be prompted as to what to say and when. We are looking for PROJECTION, DICTION and EMOTION.

PRODUCTION DETAILS: Rehearsals will be every Thursday afternoon until 5:00pm, unless otherwise instructed. The performances are most likely to be during the last week of school, with exact dates to be determined. If your child will not be available during the last week of school, he or she should not audition.

PARENT OBLIGATIONS: Upon placement in the production, there will be a fair share contribution of \$25 for participation in the production; these funds will be used to support the drama program. If a child accepts a role in the musical, the parent/guardian promises to provide the child with: a snack each Thursday afternoon (nothing with nuts, please, we need to keep an allergenfree space); a costume according to the instructions of the directors and supplied ONE MONTH prior to performances; and transportation/arrangements for the transportation of the child after each rehearsal and performance. Failure to pick up a child on time will result in that child being placed with the extended day program and the parent will be responsible for any fee incurred.

PLEASE NOTE: Failure to attend multiple rehearsals will result in either removal from the cast or potentially being recast in a smaller role in the production. Once a commitment has been made, it is expected that each child will live up to this obligation. Any absence has a negative impact on the other participants. Please do not audition if you know you cannot stay the whole rehearsal period each Thursday. Also, only cast members may attend rehearsals; non-participant siblings and friends are not permitted.

**TEACHER APPROVAL:** Each child's form <u>MUST</u> be signed by his or her homeroom teacher, indicating that the student is in good standing both academically and socially.

**REMEMBER:** Not all students who audition will be cast; participation in a previous production or chorus does not guarantee placement in the cast.
