Hello Pirate Families,

Last Wednesday, I met with a team of individuals to discuss traffic difficulties entering and leaving Palencia Elementary at morning drop off and afternoon pick up times. Included in the meeting were representatives from the County's Growth Management department, the Palencia CDD, and St. Johns County School's Operations office. Any type of physical restructuring of the entry / exit will need to be a collaborative effort due to property lines closely overlapping. It was proposed that the entry / exit be widened to allow for a left turn lane and a separate right turn lane exiting the school onto Palencia Village Drive. If this is approved, the road work would happen over the summer.

In the meantime, in an effort to get more cars off Palencia Village Drive and onto school property so that students can be dropped off in a timely fashion, we will implement a **new traffic pattern effective Friday, March 1**st. This will impact <u>morning</u> Palencia parent drop off only. Students will be dropped off in the same spot as usual. After drop off, rather than parents going straight, cars will be rerouted to the right to pass by the front of the school, wind through the lower parking lot, then back out to the round-a-bout to exit the school.

Some parents who currently use the Palencia morning drop off area might find it more efficient to use the back Las Calinas / Kensington parent drop off. This secondary parent drop off area is considerably less congested in the mornings.

There is no easy solution. A significant amount of our children live within 2 miles of the school and therefore do not qualify for school bus transportation. I sincerely appreciate your patience and support.
