I would like to begin by thanking everyone for their professionalism during the very sad event that occurred last Thursday. We appreciate the trust that was shown to our staff as we took measures to keep everyone safe. Our ability to do that is dependent on our communication with the proper authorities. The school district has systems in place to share information with our families as needed. We are very thankful for your efforts in keeping our phone lines open during this time. Please know we are constantly monitoring emergency channels for weather and other important updates. Any information that needs to be shared will be sent out as a text message.

Tuesday (tonight) is our Curriculum Chats for Kindergarten, First, and Second Grades. As a reminder the Chats begin at 6:30pm and end at 7:30pm. There is a lot of information to be shared so please be sure to arrive early as parking is limited.

St. Augustine will be celebrating its 450^{th} anniversary this weekend. A simple google search for 450^{th} will lead you to the website giving all kinds of information for this event. Next Tuesday, Sept. 8^{th} is the anniversary day and will be filled with many events. This will be a great learning opportunity for the residents of our town. We should conclude distribution of laptops and iPads this week. Many of you have purchased insurance allowing your child to take the device home. BOOSTERTHON IS UNDERWAY!


