The **Principals Math Challenge** began this week. Students at each grade level can take a timed test on basic math facts. These tests are not easy and not everyone will pass. A student must know their facts in order to pass. The tests for each grade level are as follows; Kindergarten, writing numbers correctly; 1st grade on addition, 2nd grade on subtraction, 3rd grade on multiplication, 4th grade on division and 5th grade on all four areas. In addition, staff members are encouraged to participate as role models. Once a student has passed the test they will have their name announced here and on the morning news. They will also receive a special bead for their lanyard and a *Math Matey* bracelet. If they are caught wearing the bracelet even more rewards may be earned. Our first two *Math Mateys* are Mrs. K. Worhtington and Mr. Frank. We look forward to announcing the newest members of this crew the rest of this year. Please feel free to help your child pass this challenge by practicing basic math facts with them.


