APRIL IS NATIONAL CHILD ABUSE PREVENTION MONTH

Since 1989, SAYS has been providing therapeutic residential services for boys ages 6-17 who have experienced severe emotional trauma, such as child abuse and neglect. SAYS provides a safe, stable home in which these children can live, learn, grow and heal, both physically and emotionally, from horrors children should never have to endure.

Purchase a Golf Ball
