Ahoy Palencia passengers and crew,

Good News – We now have a PSA assigned to our school. This PSA is only assigned here in the morning which is our most concentrated time. We are very thankful to have her with us and the PSA attendance has made a huge difference. Thank you to everyone for your patience as we worked to get a PSA assigned to our school.

The construction across from Avilla is impacting our bikers and walkers. Until the entrance to the new development is paved, we will continue to have a staff member helping our students get through that area. We are in communication with the site manager over both projects and they have been very informative with the school. The impact to the school should be minimal from this point forward.

We pulled results from the School Needs Assessment Survey. There are a couple comments that were common that I would like to address. Testing was a common theme in both the parent and the teacher survey. The comments were concerning too many standardized tests. The testing that we are seeing currently is a result of legislative mandates. Groups from all over the state have voiced concern over the amount of testing. As a result there is legislation moving through the braches of our state government to reduce the amount of testing given to our children. St. Johns County School has a Coordinator of Government Relations that works in Tallahassee to keep us up to date on current legislation and how it impacts our students and schools. Please watch future editions of the Pirate Post for any further updates on testing. The other concern was concerning traffic. As stated above, we now have a PSA assigned to our school and we have seen a wonderful improvement. Thank you to everyone who filled out the Survey, we have shared this information with the School Advisory Council and will use it as we direct our school.

Yesterday an email was sent to many of our families that participate in a local sports organization. This communication stated that portables would be installed this coming summer here at Palencia Elementary School. This is not the case, while we continue to grow we are not on the list to get portables this coming year. We are projected to add portable classrooms during the summer of 2016. Until then we will be utilizing Associate teachers to meet the requirement of the Class Size Amendment. I do anticipate several of our classrooms having Associate Teachers in them.

We have sent an Alert Now to our $3^{rd} - 5^{th}$ grades to go into the Home Access Center (HAC) and update the Student information. Please be sure to do this, even if there are no changes there are a couple of 'clicks' that need to be done so we know it has been updated.

Kindergarten - 2nd grade students need to return the Student Information Sheet that was sent home. It is very important that we have updated information on all our students. If you have any questions or need assistance please contact Cindy Williams at 547-4017. Enjoy your week,

SUMMER MARINE SCIENCE PROGRAM Pre-applications for the summer Marine Science Program were sent to all elementary and middle schools in the district to be passed out during the week of February 23rd. However, if your child did not receive a pre-application, they may still apply. You can download a pre-application, get all parent information, and view a video of the program by going to the Gamble Rogers Middle School website and clicking on the Marine Science link. Any questions can be answered by emailing John Gordon at john.gordon@stjohns.k12.fl.us.

This summer program is available to all students currently in grades five through eight and has been sponsored by the school district since 1982. All instructors in the program are St. Johns County School District teachers.

Three 8 day sessions are held at Gamble Rogers Middle School School with bus transportation provided. The three sessions are June 8^{th} to June 18^{th} , June 22^{nd} to July 2^{nd} , and July 6^{th} to July 16^{th} . Small classes of 12-14 students are separated by grade level.

The Marine Science Program is a carefully designed experience for responsible students who are interested in learning about our local marine environments. Learning is "hands on" in the field. Students access various marine environments while kayaking, canoeing, boating, hiking, biking, snorkeling, surfing, windsurfing, sailing, and SUP's (stand up paddleboards).

If your child is selected for the program, a final application form will be mailed out from the district office in April.
