## Ahoy Palencia passengers and crew,

We will have make-ups going on at various times as well so please watch for testing signs so we can keep the disruptions to a minimum.

The weather has been wonderful lately and it is only getting warmer as we head into the summer months. Please help your students remember the dress code as they prepare for school. A couple of things to remember are that shorts are to be no more than 4" above the knee (a good rule of thumb is that they should be fingertip length when the arms are held to the side), tops must cover the shoulder. Even if P.E. is not scheduled for that day, classes go out to recess on a daily basis.
