#### Boosterthon Is Here

This Thursday is the Boosterthon Fun Run. We would like to thank you in advance for your support of our school through this event. Last year we used funds raised from the Fun Run to help fund the Shade Structure that is being constructed this week over the basketball court. This year, funds will be used to help us pay for the Accelerated Reader program used by all our students. #### School Wide Crew System

This Thursday our students will be introduced into a CREW. Our school is divided into 4 CREWs. This is part of a school wide behavior system with the focus on positive behavior.
