The district continues to be hard at work collaborating with the St. Johns County Sheriff's Office and making safety adjustments to our buildings and policies. We welcome and encourage our families to volunteer in our schools, engage in celebrations and special events. To do so, all visitors must be approved volunteers. There are many ways to stay informed. Keep an eye out for this Pirate Post newsletter published every other week. School messenger emails or texts will be used for school-wide information that comes up in between scheduled newsletters. Teachers will also send frequent communications specific to your children and academics. It is important that your email address and your cell phone numbers are current in our system to ensure consistent communication. Make sure to gain access to Home Access Center (HAC) http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/hac/. This is an online tool for parents to monitor attendance, access report cards, assessment scores and much more for K-5. Urgent messages (ie: inclement weather, transportation delays, etc...) may be sent through text message and/or email. Visit http://www.stjohns.k12.fl.us/schoolmessenger/ to make sure you have the proper settings for school communications.

As many of you know, the first two weeks of parent drop off and pick up can be longer than usual. Thank you in advance for your patience. We will make every effort to tweak procedures as needed to ensure efficiency and safety. Carpooling, biking/walking, or taking the school bus if available is always encouraged. Please note that there are two separate parent drop off and pick up lines. Those using the Palencia parent drop off/pick up will enter the school property on Palencia Village Drive. Those using the Kensington / Las Calinas parent drop off/pick up will enter school property on Regalo Road (previously Shannon Road). We also ask that you make rainy day dismissal plans with your children if they will be biking or walking to school.

Again, welcome or welcome back to Palencia Elementary. Thank you for sharing your precious children with us. We take this responsibility very seriously and will take every opportunity to fill their days with strong academic experiences, exploration, character building, and friendships.
