- School Improvement Plan Overview.—State of FL requires each school to write a SIP. Things looked at include data from years prior; test scores (iReady and FSA). Learning Gains are looked at closely. Mrs. Goodrich shared data from last year. Areas of focus for 2022-2023
  - Instructional Practice- Focus on PLC Process.
  - Transformational Leadership- Our school will form and implement a guiding coalition for the PLC process
  - Positive Culture and Environment- Character Development/Lifelong learning (character counts)
  - ESSA Subgroup- Students with disabilities
- Update from Principal Goodrich
  - New assessments- K-2 Students are taking STAR testing, 3-5 are taking Cambium (FAST). The first two are meant to be formative- to guide instruction, and the last should be summative- what did they learn over the course of the year. This is a hold harmless year- no school grades will be given this year, but third grade students must show proficiency.
  - Typing Program- If you go through CLEVER, there is a typing program for students. (Typing.com) It is available for all students.
  - Interim reports go home 9/13/22
  - This is a district accreditation year- a parent survey will go home soon. This is different from our SAC needs assessment survey.
