- FAST-Katharine A Sharman
 - FAST vs FSA
 - Florida Assessment of Student Thinking- Covers vpk-Grade 10.
 - VPK-2 uses STAR- this is not factored into school grades. Replaces iReady.
 - 3-10 Uses Cambium- replaces FSA.
 - Both are 3x year- progress monitoring, not end of year, occurs while instruction is still occurring. Allows for adjustments to instruction.
 - Students are presented with questions from standards that are expected to be taught all year.

- Scale scores/levels are linked to FSA, since this is the first year of the test- have not actually been scaled yet. (Will be scaled this summer, which will be more accurate). For retention purposes, (3rd grade) there will be more flexibility due to the current lack of scale scores.
