- School Safety Presentation- Mike Strausbaugh, School Safety Specialist
 - Position began after Parkland Shootings He is a retired SJCSO Lieutenant.
 - What do the schools do to keep our kids safe?
 - FSSAT Florida Safe School Assessment Tool- each school submits one annually. School district and school administrators partner with first responders to focus on physical security, support, prevention, emergency planning and training.
 - Safe School Officers- each public school in SJC has a sworn deputy sheriff's officer; Every hour, every minute of every day due to statute. Total cost over \$5 million dollars.
 - School Environmental Safety Incident Reporting (SESIR) Certain incidents MUST be documented to the DOE. At least 2 individuals trained at each school.
 - Active Assailant/Hostile Intruder teachers trained during pre-planning
 - Threat Management Teams- Each school has a team, meets monthly or as needed. Each threat made is discussed.
