- Planning and Accountability Presentation by Dave Morrell, Director
  - We look at three areas to calculate school grades, achievement, learning gains, and learning gains of the lowest 25% in ELA, Math, and Science.
  - ELA also includes one more category of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade achievement.
  - Achievement is considered a level 3 or above on the FSAT assessment.
  - A learning gain is achieved by increasing a level (going from a level 2 to 3) or remaining a 3 or 4 but increase at least one scale score point. Remaining a level 5 also counts as a learning gain.
  - The lowest 25% of students count in serval categories which is why it is very important to focus those students.
  - ESSA Every Student Succeeds Act (the new No Child Left Behind). Any subgroup that scores lower than 41% on the FSAT testing becomes flagged for ESSA.
  - Palencia scored well in all areas compared to the county and the state.
