Proposal: School Recognition Funds 2022-2023 School Recognition Funds will be divided equally among all Palencia staff (instructional and non-instructional) employed at Palencia commensurate with their full or part time status during the 2022-2023 school year.

Qualification: In order for an employee to receive the School Recognition Bonus, the employee must:

- be employed at Palencia from November 1st, 2023 to April 30th, 2024.

- be free of violations related to Florida's Principles of Professional Conduct for the Education Profession
