#### Returning Student Verification 25/26 School Year

- RSV emails will be sent beginning April 14th in batches
- <u>One email per student</u> with individual 'snapcode' link sent to all parents/guardians
- Search for 'noreplyregistration@powerschool.com'
- A reply is required YES or NO
- Your reply confirms enrollment for the next school year
- It may take a week or so for you to receive the email
- Address changes including expired/expiring residency documents can be done on the RSV to avoid a second form

#### All 5th Grade Students Heading to Middle School

Must include current POR documentation. Once <u>POR</u> is reviewed and verified by the elementary school, your student's file will be released to the middle school.

Each student chose their favorite piece of art they have created this year to be framed and put on display that night for all to see. Art is available for pre-purchase though




If you haven't checked out Night of the Arts before. I highly recommend stopping by. There will be lots to see, musical performances. PE fun for the whole family, a story walk and more!


