If you would like a printed copy of the reports, please contact your child's teacher.

If you have not yet done so, now is the time to turn in the Student Information Questionnaire form, for each of your students, for the 25-26 school year. I read all forms carefully and carefully place each student at PES. While I do not take specific teacher requests, I do suggest you share teaching styles that have been or have not been a good match for your child. Summer is here! THANK YOU so much for your kind words and appreciation for all that we do here in the front office! Here are some reminders for the summer months:

- All schools will be dismissed one hour early on Friday, May 30th, 2025.
- Front Office summer hours are 8 am to 4 pm Monday through Thursday. Our offices will be closed on **Friday, July 4th, 2025**. Normal office hours will resume on **Monday, August 4th, 2025**.

Remember to complete your SJCSD Returning Student Verification Form (RSV). All guardians should have received an email from PowerSchool Enrollment beginning in April. The forms are resent by PowerSchool every two weeks until completed. **This form is required annually for all students – please complete even if your child will not be returning to SJCSD.**





Attention All Current Student Families

Returning Student Verification 25/26 School Year

- RSV emails were sent beginning April 14th in batches
- <u>One email per student</u> with individual 'snapcode' link sent to all parents/guardians
- Search for 'noreplyregistration@powerschool.com'
- A reply is required YES or NO
- Your reply confirms enrollment for the next school year
- It may take a week or so for you to receive the email
- Address changes including expired/expiring residency documents can be done on the RSV to avoid a second form

All 5th Grade Students Heading to Middle School

 Must include current Proof Of Residency (POR) documentation. Once <u>POR</u> is reviewed and verified by the elementary school, your student's file will be released to the middle school.

MESSAGES FROM OUR NURSE



As we are near the end of the school year, I would like to remind parents to stop by the clinic to pick up and sign-out medications. SJCSD policy does not allow for medication to remain in the school over the summer. Medications may not go home with the student from clinic unless they have a physician's order for self-carry.

Any medication left in the clinic after <u>Friday,May 30 at 3:30 PM</u> will be discarded according to policy unless prior arrangements have been made.

On our PES website you will find medication forms for next year. Medication orders must be completed every school year whether your child remains in the same school or goes to another. If your child has a physical examination during the summer months, this is a good time to get the medication forms completed.

For your convenience before school starts, the clinic will be open on <u>Thursday,August 7th and Friday, August 8th from 8:00am to 3:30pm</u> to accept medical supplies, medications, completed authorization or medical management forms.




